











Jerusalem, Israel:

Israel is located at the eastern end of the Mediterranean Sea. The Land of Israel, known in Hebrew as Eretz Yisrael (or Eretz Yisroel), has been sacred and important to the Jewish people since Biblical times. Israel's capital city is Jerusalem, located in the Judean Mountains, between the Mediterranean Sea and the northern edge of the Dead Sea. Since then, modern Jerusalem has grown far beyond the boundaries of the Old City.

Jerusalem has been sacred to the Jews since King David proclaimed it his capital in the 10th century BCE. Jerusalem was the site of Solomon's Temple and the Second Temple. Today, the Western Wall, a remnant of the wall surrounding the Second Temple, is a Jewish holy site second only to the Holy of Holies on the Temple Mount itself. Many Jews have "Mizrach" plaques hung on a wall of their homes to indicate the direction of prayer.

Although Jerusalem is known primarily for its religious significance, the city is also home to many artistic and cultural venues. The Israel museum is 20-acre (81,000 m²) complex that is comprised several buildings featuring special exhibits and extensive collections of Judaica, archaeological findings, and Israeli and European art. Built in 1938 during the British Mandate The Rockefeller Museum, located in East Jerusalem, was the first archaeological museum in the Middle East.


Haifa's one of the main commercial ports in Israel, was founded approximately 1800 years ago in the time of the Mishna. Haifa originates from the Hebrew words "Chof Yafeh, which is translated as beautiful shore, and is built around Mount Carmel. Mount Carmel is closely associated with the prophet Eliyahu, and it is believed that Eliayhu lived in a cave that is located on the side of Mount Carmel in seclusion.

Among its many attractions, Haifa is home to the ship *Af Al Pi Chen*, the centerpiece of the Clandestine immigration and Navy Museum in addition to Acre, one of the oldest continuously inhabited sites in Israel.

Tiberias is the Jewish people's political and religious hub, as well as the center of Jewish spiritual creativity. Located in Tiberias is the Rambam's Grave. Here one can enjoy a variety of activities in a city that offers wonderful opportunities to mix relaxation with nature, history with contemporary attractions, serene quiet with active water sports, and pilgrimage sites with unique tourist attractions.

Jerusalem is a city of overwhelming emotions, a city that promises a religious and spiritual experience, excitement and pleasure, interesting tours and entertaining adventures. Here, alongside Jerusalem's fascinating historic and archeological sites, there are amazingly modern tourist attractions for all lovers of culture, the arts, theater and music, architecture and gastronomic delights. Located in the heart of the city the **Western Wall** is venerated as the sole remnant of the Holy Temple. It has become a place of pilgrimage for Jews, as it is the closest permitted accessible site to the holiest spot in Judaism, namely the *Even ha-shetiya* or Foundation Stone, which lies on the Temple Mount.









The Dead Sea is flanked by mountains to the east and the rolling hills of Jerusalem to the west, giving it an almost other-worldly beauty. Although sparsely populated and serenely quiet now, the area is believed to have been home to five Biblical cities: Sodom, Gomorrah, Adman, Zebouin and Zoar (Bela).

Caesarea (also known as Caesarea Palaestina and Caesarea Maritima) is an ancient city, now archaeological park, located on the Mediterranean Sea 33 miles north of Joppa and 60 miles northwest of Jerusalem. Constructed by Herod the Great between 22 and 10 BC and named for Caesar Augustus.

Golan Heights It was once called the *Bashan* and was inhabited by mighty nations ruled by Kings *Sichon* and *Og* whom *Moshe* and *Bnei Yisroel* destroyed before entering into *Eretz Yisroel*. The northern part of it was given to *Shevet Menashe* while *Shevet Reuven* and *Gad*, resided farther south (in the area across the *Kinneret* and the upper and lower part of the *Yarden*).

Tsfat, is the highest city in the Galilee and of Israel. Considered one of Judaism's Four Holy Cities, Tsfat has remained a center of Kabbalah, also known as Jewish mysticism, since the sixteenth century.


