BRAZIL

With a surface of 8.5 million Km2, Brazil is almost as big as Europe covering half of the South American continent, it has an estimated population of 209 million inhabitants and its official currency is Real (R\$). The climate differs according to zone and altitude, but overall Equatorial and Tropical are the main ones along most of the territory, the highest temperatures occur in the Northeast area and the lowest in the lower lands of Southeast and South regions. Brazil, a country of immense proportions and contrasts, has an enigmatic pull on many people. Since the sixteenth century, when the Portuguese first settle in the country, Brazil has had this mesmerizing effect on foreigners. First there was gold, then rubber followed by coffee and nowadays it is above all the rhythms and the rich culture that appeal to tourists. Brazilians tend to display a lot of happiness, kindness and spontaneity. The biggest country of South America is a mirror of fascinating pictures.



Rio de Janeiro is also called the "Marvelous City". Located by the Atlantic Ocean, golden beaches adorn its shores backed with lush mountains. ARGENTINA

Being an important economic and cultural center, it is considered the capital of the Tango (Argentinean Dance). Windsor Leme Hotel or similar

The grand Windsor Leme Hotel is a towering 17-story building in Rio de Janeiro located at the north end of the world-famous Copacabana Beach, adjacent to Sugar Loaf Mountain and Leme Palace, and just miles from the glorious Ipanema Beach. The surrounding upper-middle-class neighborhood of Leme gets its name from a rock formation that exhibits characteristics of a ship's rudder.

Loi Suites Recoleta Hotel or similar



ITINERARY

Day 1: Welcome to Rio de Janeiro.

You will be welcomed at the Rio de Janeiro airport and driven to your hotel in the south zone.

Take a unique walking tour and hear the legends and stories woven through Rio's downtown narrow streets and old historical buildings. Choose to visit the **Casa França-Brasil** and see the same exhibitions that deal with the country's politics and culture. On Gonçalves Dias Street, go to Rio's century-old **coffee shop**: "Confeitaria" **Colombo**. Admire the tall ceilings, marble details, and elegant atmosphere as you sip on a flavorful cup of coffee. During your tour, walk by some of the city's most important and beautiful landmarks like the "Banco do Brazil" Cultural Center, the Paço Imperial, Praça XV, and the "Travessa do Mercado".

Overnight in Rio de Janeiro. (L, D).

Day 2: Rio de Janeiro.

Half day City Tour and Sugar Loaf. Walk along the cobblestone streets in old Rio as you appreciate the beautiful architecture. Day 3: Rio de Janeiro.

Drive to the Cosme Velho district where you take a cogwheel train through the Tijuca forest up the **Corcovado Mountain**. Along the way, appreciate the lush rainforest and the views. When you arrive at the top, admire the well-known **Corcovado** statue, one of the world's wonders. From one of Rio de Janeiro's most privileged belvederes, appreciate the panoramic views of the city and its surroundings. Make your way back down and end your tour with stops at the famous, white sandy **beaches** of Copacabana, Ipanema, and Leblon and return to your hotel.

Discover Rio at night as you head **downtown** to the bohemian area of Lapa. At the **Rio Scenarium**, an old baronial town house, immerse completely in **Brazilian culture**: music, eclectic antiques, and a mix of vintage items like an old pharmacy from the 1930s, Chinese ceramics, and other unusual objects. Listed as one of the **best bars/nightclubs** in the world, locals and tourists enjoy fun evenings to the rhythms of excellent **live Brazilian music**. Overnight in Rio de Janeiro. (B, L, D).

Day 4: Rio de Janeiro to Buenos Aires, Argentina. Transfers from Hotel to the Airport.

Upon arrival, you will be welcomed at the international airport and taken to your hotel.

Leave your hotel and drive 33 km (21mi.) north to the capital's outskirts. **Tigre** is a popular weekend getaway for many "porteños" and boasts many summer homes as well as yacht and rowing clubs. Take **1h** - **boat excursion** (**shared**) along the Paraná Delta and its **channels**, rivers, streams, and numerous islands, appreciating the lush vegetation.

Day 5: Buenos Aires, Argentina.

Enjoy breakfast at your hotel, then get in touch with the birth city of the Tango. This is the perfect tour to discover the charm of Argentina's capital, from the chic districts of Recoleta and Palermo, to historic Plaza de Mayo, and on to architectural icons such as the Colon opera house, the Metropolitan Cathedral, and the palace of Congress. After lunch the program continues with visits to old town San Telmo, home of the city's aristocracy until the late 19th century; Caminito street, in La Boca, the colorful shelter for Italian immigrants; and the thriving restaurant scene at the Puerto Madero waterfront. Visit to the Jewish site and Synagogues.

Day 7: Buenos Aires to Iguazu Falls.

At the given time, you will be picked up and taken to the domestic airport to board your flight to Puerto Iguazu.

Upon arrival, you will be welcomed at Puerto Iguazu airport and taken to your hotel in the Argentinean side.

Leave your hotel and drive to the Iguazú National Park in Argentina. From the visitor's center, take the train and go to the **Upper Circuit** as you appreciate the panoramic views of the falls. Arrive at the **Devil's Throat**, the park's most impressive and immense waterfalls. Measuring 150m (492ft.) long and 80m (262ft.) high; its horseshoe shape creates a stunning waterfall you will remember forever. From here, walk along the Iguazú River canyon for about 3km (1,87mi.) to the **lower circuit** as you admire the regional **fauna and flora** and feel the constant presence of the waterfalls.

At the given time, you will be picked up at your hotel and taken to the airport for your flight to your next destination.

Upon arrival, you will be welcomed at the airport and taken to your hotel.

Day 8: Buenos Aires.

Leisure day for shopping.

At the given time, you will be picked up and taken to the International Airport to board your international flight back to USA. (B, L).
